# FOOTHILL BOULEVARD EMERGENCY WATER PIPE LINING PROJECT

JUNE/JULY 2014

Salt Lake City Department of Public Utilities is beginning a major emergency pipe rehabilitation project on Foothill Boulevard/Foothill Drive between 1300 South and Sunnyside on **Monday**, **June 9**<sup>th</sup>, **2014**.

The existing 32-inch welded steel water transmission main located in Foothill Blvd/Foothill Drive has had numerous breaks over its lifespan. The pipe was originally installed in 1947 to provide a redundant source of water to the University of Utah and Downtown area. The frequencies of leaks in the last few months require an acceleration of the pipe rehabilitation schedule. A trenchless method of lining the pipe on the inside has been chosen to minimize costs and impacts to the public. The work will take 2-4 weeks to complete.

### **Schedule**

Construction starts Monday, June 9, 2014 with anticipated completion scheduled by July 3, 2014. Construction hours will be 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM - Monday through Saturday.

### **Construction Impacts**

The impacts will include lane closures and detours. Water service should not be impacted. Construction staging and pipe layout will impact Foothill Drive. Pit excavation will impact Foothill Boulevard.

## **Anticipated Road Closures and Detours**

Southbound Foothill Boulevard will have two travel lanes open at all times and during afternoon peak hours (3:00 pm to 8:00 pm)

all three lanes will be open yet motorists should expect lane shifts with some delay traveling through the project corridor.

Eastbound and westbound left turn lanes off Foothill Blvd at the 1300 South intersection will be closed during construction. Choose alternate routes on 2100 East and 2300 East for left turn movements.

To avoid delays, choose alternate travel times or routes.

### Safety

Safety is a top priority for Salt Lake City Public Utilities. We appreciate efforts to keep pedestrians, particularly children, away from construction equipment and work areas. If you see any trespassing in construction areas, please report to the police dispatcher at 801-799-4600.

### **Easements**

Work will be conducted in existing City and Utah Department of Transportation Right-of-Way.
