Clean-Out Box Lid Reconstruction Project

Public Utilities has a clean-out box lid repair project scheduled for construction in the Sugar House neighborhood.

A clean-out box or COB is an access point on a storm drain pipeline, similar to a manhole on a sewer line. The COB is used to inspect and clean the pipeline.

The top of a COB is exposed to traffic and the elements. This leads the top to wear out faster than the below ground portion.

This project is to replace the top of the boxes and hatches on some of the existing COBs in the Sugar House area, which extends the life of the facility.

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

On Sunday, August 30th, the top of the COB in the intersection of 2100 South and Highland Drive (1100 East) will be replaced. Due to the close proximity of residences and noise restrictions, the work must occur during waking hours.

Up to three feet of excavation around the COB can be expected. The existing concrete will have to be removed from the existing boxes. Some noise should be expected during this operation.

The excavations will either be barricaded or covered with steel plates when not being worked upon. It is anticipated that each box location maybe barricaded or plated for up to two weeks.

ROAD CLOSURES AND DETOURS

The intersection of 2100 South and Highland Drive (1100 East) will be restricted to one-lane in all directions and no left turns. This restriction will be in place from 8:00 am Sunday, August 30th until 10:00 am Monday, August 31st.
