I am writing to express my concern regarding the proposed major alteration to the Carlson House at 378 N. Quince Street, a designated local landmark.

As a neighboring resident and someone who values the preservation of our community's historic character, I believe this proposal warrants careful review and greater public transparency. Because the Carlson House is a protected local landmark, any significant alterations have the potential to affect not only the property itself but also the historic integrity of the neighborhood.

Before the Commission weighs this decision, I respectfully request that additional information about the proposed alterations be made available to neighboring property owners and the broader community. This could include detailed plans, renderings, and an explanation of how the proposed changes comply with the City's historic preservation standards. Providing this information in advance would allow residents to better understand the proposal and offer meaningful public input.

Historic landmark designation exists to preserve the architectural and cultural heritage of our community. Once significant alterations are approved, the historic character of these irreplaceable resources can be permanently diminished. For that reason, it is essential that proposed changes receive thorough public review and that preservation of the property's historic integrity remain the Commission's highest priority.

I appreciate the Commission's commitment to protecting our historic resources and respectfully ask that you ensure this proposal is reviewed with the utmost care and that neighboring residents are given adequate opportunity to understand and comment on the proposed changes before any final decision is made.
