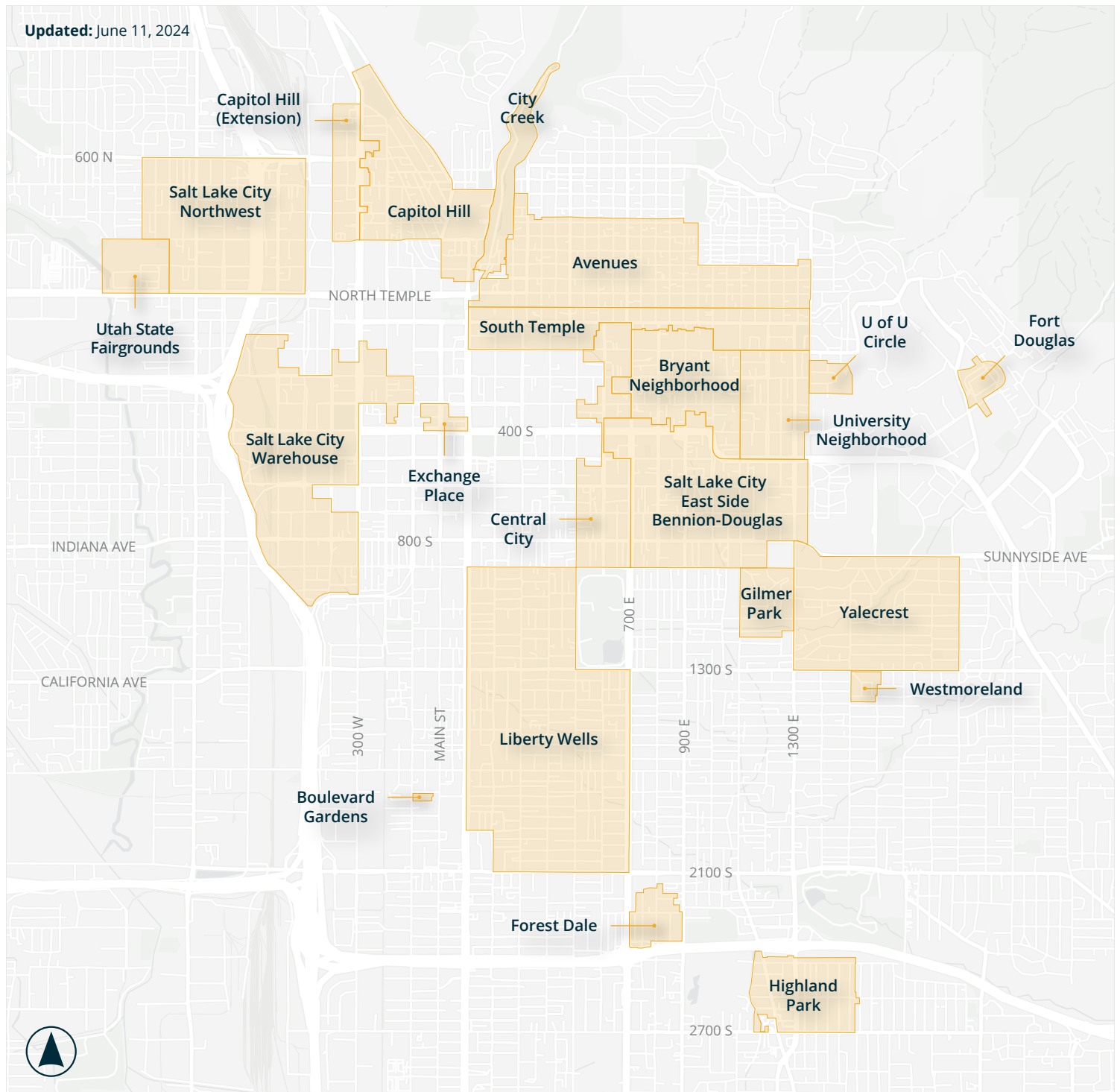

National Historic Districts are listed as resources in the National Register of Historic Places.

Listing at the national level does not restrict what a property owner may do with a property and it provides federal or state tax credits for the rehabilitation project. It does not protect historic properties from alteration or demolition.

All locally-designated districts in Salt Lake City are listed on the National Register, but not all National Register districts are locally-designated.
