My family has lived in my home in Glendale since the mid-1980s. I have watched the neighborhood go through many changes, and my family has been part of this community through them.

I understand the need for more affordable single-family housing throughout Salt Lake City and Salt Lake County. Glendale residents also want genuinely affordable housing. However, our neighborhood's roads and infrastructure were not designed to support high-density development. We already struggle with increased traffic, rising home prices, and high rents.

Many developers entering the area are not part of our community and may not fully understand our concerns about traffic, shared community spaces, and the neighborhood's character.

I oppose high-density development in Glendale. I want residents to have an opportunity to consider housing options that fit the scale and character of our community, provide truly affordable homes, reduce the impact of vehicle traffic, and support a safer, more walkable neighborhood.
