Project Benefits

- Enhance stream functionality through stabilization of the bank and creation of riparian corridor.
- Increase positive user experience by providing space for interaction with natural stream channel
- Enhance biodiversity through vegetation and stream improvements.

Project Scope

The project area includes the entire stretch of the Fairmont Park stream from Youth City to East and extending to the Boys and Girls club to the West. The stream is an underutilized natural feature within the Park and these improvements will improve the aesthetics and functionality of the stream through the Park.

Proposed Improvements Include:

- Stabilization of the stream channel through the use of boulders and plantings.
- Removal invasive Phragmites that limits visual and physical access to the stream channel.
- Plant riparian trees and shrubs to enhance the corridor.
- Create a safe and accessible stream corridor that encourages interaction among park visitors.
