Mobile Operation on a Two-Lane Road Using Flaggers

(15 minutes or less per work area and traveling at less than 5 mph) – (cont.)

Notes

- 1. The distance between ROAD WORK AHEAD signs should not exceed approximately 2 miles.
- Where feasible, well defined end points (e.g. intersections, major driveways, city limits, etc.) should be used to establish the limits of the work zone.
- 3. FLAGGER warning signs should be repositioned periodically as the operation moves.
- Suggested protection vehicle configuration includes rotating beacons, flashers and a truck mounted attenuator.
- If there is a sideroad intersection within the work area, additional traffic control, such as flaggers and appropriate signage, may be needed on the sideroad approaches.
